▲**Save \$2 on your monthly premium!** Enroll in our Automatic Bank Draft or Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) program and you will save \$2 on your monthly premium. (To enroll, simply complete the Premium Payment Form.)

Save \$48 by paying your premium for the entire year!
(Note: Based on the policy effective date, the discount may be pro-rated the first year.)

Save 5% when more than one member in the household enrolls in a Medicare Supplement plan with us. The discount is for policies with effective dates of June 1, 2010 or after and available to those members who occupy the same housing unit.

◆**Enroll when first eligible**

Certain applicants are eligible for discounted rates if they enroll in a plan when they are first eligible for Medicare. The discount is a 3-year program, which starts with a 15% discount off the standard rate in year 1 and declines.

Initial Eligibility Discount Rates apply for applicants who enroll:

- No more than 3 months after the month they turn 65;
- No more than 3 months after losing eligibility for group continuation coverage; or
- No more than 3 months after the month Medicare Part B benefits become effective.

Applicant not enrolling when first eligible are subject to a 20% surcharge to the standard rate and can only enroll in Standard Rate A. After 12 months of continuous enrollment in Plan A, members can change plans at the standard rate.

These Initial Eligibility Discounts are not available to those individuals that are Medicare eligible due to a disability or ESRD and under age 65.
